Scholarship Awards

Mendocino Forest Products awards 7 scholarships to Class of 2015 high school seniors

Seven (7) scholarships to Class of 2015 graduating high school seniors in Northern California, Oregon and Colorado were awarded by our collective companies (Mendocino[®] Forest Products and affiliates). The scholarship recipients are pursuing fields of study in environmental science, engineering, animal science, medicine, business management, and sports medicine. \$4,000 will be awarded to each recipient over a 4-year period. Scholarship money is distributed directly to the award recipient and used at their discretion for tuition or other college expenses.

The company's scholarship program encourages students furthering education in their field of interest. Students receiving the scholarship will be enrolled in accredited four-year college or enrolled in a two-year junior college with continued enrollment at an accredited four-year college in the 3rd and 4th years of their education.

Scholarships are selected on the basis of academic achievement, extracurricular and community activities, a one-page essay, and extraordinary and compelling circumstances.

Since the company's first award in 2006, the company has awarded 41 scholarships worth approximately \$220,000. In addition to the seven (7) scholarships announced today, there are 21 students currently receiving scholarships from previous awards years.
