SCOTIA PACIFIC COMPANY, LLC'S JOINDER IN RELIEF REQUESTED IN PETITION FOR PERMISSION TO APPEAL

On this date, The Bank of New York Mellon Trust Company, N.A. (f/k/a The Bank of New York Trust Company, N.A.) filed in this Court its Petition for Permission to Appeal Filed By Indenture Trustee (the "Indenture Trustee's Petition") relating to the Bankruptcy Court's Judgment and Order (I) Confirming First Amended Joint Plan of Reorganization for the Debtors, as Further Modified, with Technical Amendments, Proposed by Mendocino Redwood Company, LLC, Marathon Structured Finance Fund, L.P., and the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors, (II) Denying Confirmation of the Indenture Trustee Plan, and (III) Denying Motion to Appoint a Chapter 11 Trustee [Dkt. No. 3302] (See Tab 2 to Indenture Trustee's Petition).

Petitioner Scotia Pacific Company, LLC ("Scopac"), is one of the debtors in the Bankruptcy Court below. Scopac also filed a Notice of Appeal From Confirmation Order [Dkt. 3315].
