## **Project Description**

**Title:** Bank Swallow Surveys for Class I Water Crossings

Purpose: Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) monitoring

**Date Initiated:** March 1999

Projected End Date: Ongoing

Manager: Sal Chinnici, Forest Science Manager

## **Executive Summary:**

The HRC HCP Section 6.7 (PALCO 1999), Bank Swallow Conservation Plan, requires that surveys be conducted where new road construction crossing low gradient Class I waters is planned and potential bank swallow (*Riparia riparia*) habitat exists within 200 feet. No crossings were established in 2014 that required bank swallow surveys to be conducted. In addition, there was no stockpiled sand or gravel from gravel extraction operations during the bank swallow breeding period. Therefore, no bank swallow surveys were done in 2014 on HRC property.

No change in monitoring strategies or intensity is recommended at this time.
