Tan Oak Treatment per Acre:	0.62 dry pounds or 0.155 gallons per acre treated - 2.5 measuring cups per acre
Tan Oak Treatment on Ownership to Date:	40,400 pounds or 10,100 gallons over 16 years
Tan Oak Treatment Acres Treated Since 1998:	65,056 acres frill method over 16 years
Average conifer trees per acre after treatment:	225

Grown more than 14 million conifer trees on treated tan oak acres over 16 years.
